

At its meeting on 16 June Council made the following decisions:

- Awarded Coastal building company Fairbrother Pty Ltd the contract for construction of the new \$3.2 million West Park Sports Complex.
- Agreed to amend the Marine Terrace Car Park's opening hours. The car park will remain open seven days a week from 7.30am until 9pm but operate from 10am until 9pm on Sundays.
- Agreed not to proceed with the disposal of a portion of public land at Jorgenson Street Reserve.
- Approved a 15-residential lot subdivision at 11 Roslyn Avenue.
