

## At its meeting on 21 July Burnie City Council agreed to:

- Implement a dedicated right turn lane and turn signal at the intersection of Wilmot St and Alexander St, west bound as stage one of measures to reduce traffic volumes in Queen St.
- Prepare a further report on future sustainability of sporting infrastructure following the Recreation Strategy Review. Council will consult with sporting groups impacted by any changes.
- Wind-up Burnie Water Pty Ltd, which was a strategy introduced in April 2007 as part of Council's fight against the statewide water and sewerage reform.
