

## At its meeting on 15 September Council agreed to:

- Endorse the concept design for a new Burnie Aquatic and Leisure Centre at West Park, subject to the expression of interest process and significant government funding to support the project.
- Improve lighting on the stairway to the Basalt Column Car Park and investigate the possibility of a partnership with an outside source to operate the Marine Terrace Car Park, after 9pm.
- Write to Infrastructure Minister Graeme Sturges inviting him to meet with Council and discuss the importance of port and rail for Burnie. Council will also approach the Federal Government to advise changes and seek additional funding to complete the Oakleigh Park pedestrian crossing.
- Request a meeting with the Department of Infrastructure, Energy and Resources representatives to discuss DIER'S areas of responsibility with roads in the Burnie municipality, in particular Mount Street.
- Accept a grant from DIER to facilitate the development of an area development plan, draft scheme amendment and information memorandum for the development of the Phantom Valley area in the Tarkine.
