Burnie waterfront claims two Keep Australia Beautiful Awards

Burnie's waterfront claimed two awards at today's Keep Australia Beautiful Awards in Oatlands.

Burnie City Council won the Clean Beach Award for its waterfront development and is now a national finalist.

Council also claimed the Certificate of Excellence Award in the Community Action Category for the North Terrace Streetscape project.

Burnie Mayor Alwyn Boyd accepted the awards saying he was proud to receive both honours on behalf of the City.
