Business as usual for Pioneer Village Museum

It will be business as usual for the Pioneer Village Museum from Monday.

After temporarily closing in April, the museum will reopen its doors from 10am until 3pm, Monday to Friday.

Burnie Mayor Alwyn Boyd said the Museum's temporary closure was to enable the selection of more than 200 items to be displayed at the new Makers' Workshop, which opens Sunday.

Mayor Boyd said the reopening of the Museum coincided with the start of another bumper cruise ship season, with two cruise ship visits on Tuesday and Wednesday next week.

"What an exciting week ahead for Burnie and a perfect time to showcase our City to these world travelers," Mayor Boyd said.

"While the Museum has been temporarily closed, it has still been accessible to the public through bookings.

"During this time, Council has been exploring plans for the museum, which includes group tours and promotions."
